COLLECTION SERVICES

PLEASE REFER TO THE ACTUAL CALENDAR PAGE FOR YOUR COLLECTION SCHEDULE.

ALL COLLECTION SERVICES MAY BE SUSPENDED DURING ICE AND SNOW STORMS OR HURRICANES. IF THIS OCCURS ON YOUR SCHEDULED PICKUP DAY, GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES WILL BE COLLECTED THE FOLLOWING SATURDAY. PLEASE VISIT OUR WEBSITE AT WWW.MORRISTWP.COM FOR ANNOUNCEMENTS AND UPDATES DURING SEVERE WEATHER. PLEASE KEEP THE AREA WHERE GARBAGE AND RECYCLING IS PLACED CLEAR FOR SAFE FOOTING.

GARBAGE: (Standard 32g gallon container)

1. Picked up weekly
2. Placed at curbside by 6:00 AM of scheduled day
(Memorial Day to Labor Day - 5:30 AM)
3. Six (6) item limit (Call 973-326-7398 for large or extra items)
Wrap large glass doors with cardboard and tape
Rugs: Cut, rolled, and tied (50 pound limit/roll)
If moving, please notify us well in advance
4. Items not to be more than four (4) feet in length
5. Standard **32 gallon** garbage cans only with lids/handles or plastic bags (50 pound limit/container)
6. No construction materials
7. No household hazardous waste
8. **LATEX PAINT - MUST BE DRIED OUT IN CANS BEFORE DISPOSAL. CAT LITTER WORKS WELL.**
9. Animal feces should be placed in paper bags before being placed in garbage containers.
10. **Wrap all mattresses in plastic before disposal.**

AUTOMATED TRASH COLLECTION: (Residents issued Automated Trash Carts)

1. Picked up weekly
2. Placed at curbside by 6:00 AM of scheduled day
(Memorial Day to Labor Day- 5:30 AM)
3. **KEEP CART AWAY FROM ALL OBSTRUCTIONS, FACE ARROWS TOWARDS THE STREET AND ALLOW 4 FT OF SPACE ON ALL SIDES OF TRASH CART.**
4. **Do not place near mailboxes, under trees, or in close proximity to other containers or vehicles.**
5. All large items must be called into the DPW Office at 973-326-7398 for collection. The items will be collected by a separate vehicle on your scheduled collection day. Please follow all guidelines outlined here.
 - Wrap large glass doors with cardboard and tape
 - Rugs: Cut, rolled, and tied (50 pound limit/roll)
 - Items not to be more than four (4) feet in length
 - If moving, please notify us well in advance
6. No construction materials
7. No household hazardous waste
8. **LATEX PAINT - MUST BE DRIED OUT IN CANS BEFORE DISPOSAL. CAT LITTER WORKS WELL.**
9. Animal feces should be placed in paper bags before being placed in trash cart.
10. **Wrap all mattresses in plastic before disposal.**

GARBAGE:

Your cooperation is appreciated in keeping our sanitation workers health and safety in mind. **Please use the proper receptacles.**

TOWNSHIP ISSUED AUTOMATED TRASH COLLECTION PROGRAM:

All residents utilizing the Automated Trash Carts must review and follow the guidelines listed below in order to enable our collection crews to collect your trash as efficiently and safely as possible.

- Keep cart away from all obstructions, face arrows towards the street and allow 4 feet of space on all sides of trash cart (Example #1)
- Do not place near mailboxes, under trees, or in close proximity to other containers or vehicles (Example #2)

RECEPTACLES AND/OR TRASH CARTS SHALL BE PLACED AT THE CURB BEGINNING AT DUSK ON THE NIGHT PRECEDING THE SCHEDULED COLLECTION DAY. RECEPTACLES AND/OR TRASH CARTS SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE CURB BY 6:00 PM OF THE EVENING OF THE COLLECTION DAY.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) DISPOSAL

The County of Morris provides a program for the safe disposal of HHW such as oil-based paint, paint thinners, gasoline, herbicides, pesticides, acids, car batteries, propane tanks, etc. The County facility is located in Mount Olive and open to county residents by appointment only. To schedule an appointment, call the Morris County Municipal Utility Authority (MUA) at 973-829-8006. The facility is open on select Tuesdays and Fridays (9 to 11 AM) and Saturdays (8:00 to 11:00 AM). Drop-off events are held periodically at the Morris County Public Safety Training Academy, 500 West Hanover Ave., Parsippany. Visit the MUA's website at www.mcmua.com for more information.

SYRINGES

If you are a diabetic or a person taking medication by injection, **DO NOT THROW OUT YOUR USED SYRINGES!** They are not accepted at the County Transfer Station and cannot be recycled. To protect the safety of your sanitation and recycling workers, please register for the Safe Syringe Disposal program at Morristown Memorial Hospital. The program is FREE. Call 973-971-4177 for details.

RECYCLING:

1. Picked up weekly. Please refer to the calendar for your street schedule and specific material(s) for collection.
2. Placed at curbside by 6 AM of scheduled day. (**Memorial Day to Labor Day – 5:30 AM.**)
3. **NEWSPAPER: (INCLUDING INSERTS)**
Tied in bundles with string (50 pound limit per bundle).
4. **MAGAZINES/JUNKMAIL:** Tied in bundles or put in paper shopping bags. Bundles and bags can be put into a standard trash can with lid appropriately marked. Include JUNKMAIL with MAGAZINES. Gift wrapping paper is also included with these materials. No hardcover or telephone books
5. **CORRUGATED CARDBOARD/CHIPBOARD (CEREAL AND SHOE BOXES, ETC.) and BROWN SHOPPING BAGS:** Broken down and tied same as newspaper.
6. **COMINGLED GLASS FOOD JARS/BEVERAGE BOTTLES; ALUMINUM BEVERAGE CANS; STEEL FOOD/BEVERAGE CANS; PLASTIC SODA/MILK/WATER BOTTLES AND OTHER PLASTIC CODED 1 through 7 (NO BUBBLE WRAP OR PLASTIC PACKAGING MATERIAL), AND CARTONS (SEE DEFINITION OF CARTON IN PAGES TO FOLLOW)** Rinse and place in a weatherproof container (standard 32 gallon type garbage can with lid and handles); 50 pound limit per container. No plastic or paper bags to be used as containers. **PLEASE SEE ABC'S OF PLASTIC RECYCLING.**
7. **RECYCLING DROP-OFF CENTER:** All recyclables are acceptable. Located at the DPW. Hours: Monday thru Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM and Saturday 6 AM to 2:00PM.
8. **MOTOR OIL:** Must be brought to the DPW Recycling Drop-off Center.
9. **RECHARGEABLE TYPE BATTERIES ONLY ARE RECYCLABLE:** These batteries are accepted at the Recycling Drop-off Center and the Township Municipal Building, Main Lobby, located on Woodland Avenue. **PLEASE DO NOT PUT RECHARGEABLE TYPE BATTERIES IN WITH GARBAGE.**
Examples are:
 - Ni-Cad Batteries used in cordless power tools and cordless house phones
 - Lithium Batteries used in cell phones, digital cameras, watches, hearing aides
10. **ELECTRONIC RECYCLING PROGRAM.** Morris Township is now recycling electronic equipment at the DPW Yard located on Jane Way. All electronic equipment will be accepted between the hours of 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM Monday thru Friday and 6:00 AM to 2:00 PM Saturday.

ACCEPTABLE ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

Computers, monitors, wires & cables, keyboard and mouse, telephones, fax machines, cell phones, pda's, household electronics, small stereos, televisions (32 inches or less), VCR, DVD players, and microwaves.

NONACCEPTABLE ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

DVD's, VHS tapes, floppies, cd's, toaster ovens, blenders, vacuum cleaners, or any electronics housed in wood cabinets.

USED TIRES:

1. Bring to the DPW
2. \$3 fee per tire
3. No rims.

Fuel Saving Tip

Crushing plastic and aluminum containers not only gives you more room in your recycling container but allows us more room in our collection vehicles. So please remember to rinse out all containers thoroughly and crush containers whenever possible before placing them at the curb for collection. This allows for maximum collection of the most space consuming items.

LARGE METAL ITEMS: APPLIANCES, YARD SHEDS, SWING SETS, TIRE RIMS, ETC.

1. Service provided the last week of the month by call in to 973-326-7398. Please call one week in advance. **NOTE: This service will not be available from October through December.**
2. No propane tanks accepted. Please call the Morris County Municipal Utility Authority at 973-829-8006.

CHRISTMAS TREES: Picked up during the month of January (weather permitting).

GRASS CLIPPINGS/LEAVES/PLANT WASTE/LIGHT BRUSH: (April through September)

1. Curbside pickup of grass clippings, leaves, plant waste, and light brush is picked up **the second Saturday for Zone 1 and the third Saturday for Zone 2 each month** beginning **April 9th and ending September 17th**. Please review the calendar for your street listing and scheduled collection day.
2. Place in 32 gallon standard garbage cans with lid and handles.
3. Grass clippings, leaves, plant waste, and light brush can be mixed together during this period. Light brush may also be tied with string in bundles no longer than 4 feet or placed in 32 gallon standard garbage cans cut to the height of the garbage can.
4. **NO PLASTIC BAGS.**
5. Fifty (50) pound limit per can or bundle.
6. **NO DIRT, LOGS, ROOTS, OR STUMPS.**
7. Residents (No contractors) may bring **grass clippings and light brush** to the Department of Public Works site on Jane Way off West Hanover Avenue during business hours. Plastic bags may be used for this method of disposal. Please be prepared to remove all materials from plastic bags for disposal.
8. The Department of Public Works will be available for **RESIDENTS ONLY** (No Contractors) to bring their grass clippings and light brush on Saturdays from April to October from **6:00 am to 2:00 pm**. Please refer to the calendar for specific dates.

LEAVES/GRASS CLIPPINGS/PLANT WASTE: (October through December)

In order to comply with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Storm Water Regulations, during the period of October 17th thru mid-December, leaves/grass clippings/plant waste are to be placed out for collection in neat piles at the curb but NOT ON THE PAVEMENT NOR WITHIN 10 FEET OF A STORM DRAIN (CATCH BASIN).

1. **DO NOT PLACE BRUSH IN LEAF PILES.**
2. **DO NOT PLACE BRUSH AT THE CURB WITH REGULAR GARAGE.** During this period, residents may bring light brush to the Department of Public Works site on Jane Way off West Hanover Avenue.

ABC'S OF PLASTIC RECYCLING

Help keep plastic out of the landfill. Here's an easy way to recycle plastic classes 1-7.

You may deposit your qualified recyclable plastic at your curbside or at the recycling depot in the same way and on the same schedule you do currently. Please follow the rules stated below. If you wish to dispose of oversized class 1-7 objects, please transport them to the depot on Jane Way.

Before putting any plastic item into your recycling bin, ask yourself:

- 1) Does it have any of the below listed symbols stamped on it?
(Most recycling symbol codes are located on or near the bottom of plastic containers.)



If a **PLASTIC** item has a Recycling Code 1 thru 7 marked on it, please recycle that item. Some examples of acceptable items are those used for soda, water, juice, milk, shampoo, laundry detergent, squeezable bottles (honey, mustard) blister packs, cat litter pails, yogurt, margarine, bottle caps, small toys, compact disk cases, plastic take-out food, medicine, and baby bottles. These items will be collected with your current recycling curbside collection.

Due to collection truck characteristics, items larger than a 5 gallon pail will not be picked up from curbside. You may bring large qualified class 1-7 objects such as toys, outdoor furniture, and PVC water pipes to the Department of Public Works Recycling Depot located on Jane Way off West Hanover Ave.

Please clean containers before recycling.

RECYCLE ONLY plastic items stamped class 1-7

DO NOT RECYCLE containers that had contained hazardous materials, such as motor oil, antifreeze, etc.

Styrofoam, plastic bags, bubble wrap, ceramics, window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, hangers, or foil will not be accepted.

NOTE: Some grocery stores collect plastic bags for recycling. Plastic bags are acceptable at these locations as advertised, but they are not acceptable as part of your curbside collection program.

Recycling Depot Hours: Monday – Friday 7:00 AM - 3:00 PM and Saturday 6:00 AM – 2:00 PM

BATTERY RECYCLING

Rechargeable type batteries (Ni-Cad, Lithium, and Button Type Batteries) are accepted at the Department of Public Works Recycling Depot located on Jane Way, Monday-Friday from 7:00 AM - 3:00 PM and Saturday from 7:00 AM - 2:00 PM. The Municipal Building, 50 Woodland Avenue is another drop off location Monday-Friday from 8:30 AM - 4:30 PM.

TYPE OF BATTERIES RECYCLED

Ni-Cad batteries used in cordless power tools and cordless house phones. Lithium Batteries used in cell phones, digital cameras, and computers. Button type batteries used in watches and hearing aids.



TYPE OF BATTERIES NOT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING

Alkaline type batteries (AA, AAA, C, D, 9 Volt) made after 1994 are not considered hazardous waste. Please dispose of these type batteries in with your garbage.



GUIDELINES FOR PROPER DISPOSAL OF HOUSEHOLD MEDICATION

Over-the-counter and prescription medications should not be disposed of down the drain. Wastewater treatment facilities are not designed to remove pharmaceutical compounds, and they may end up in your local waterways, which may eventually be found in drinking water. Properly disposing of unwanted and expired prescriptions and over-the-counter medications in the trash promotes a healthy aquatic environment and prevents accidental poisoning and intentional abuse.

- 1. Keep medicine in original container. Mark out personal information on prescription bottles.**
- 2. Mix liquid medicine with undesirable substances like coffee grinds, cat litter, or dirt. Dilute pills with water, and then add coffee grinds, cat litter, or dirt.**
- 3. Place bottles in an opaque container, such as a yogurt container, and secure lid, or wrap in a dark-colored plastic bag.**
- 4. Hide the container in the trash. Do not recycle.**

Do NOT dispose of medication down the drain or toilet. Do NOT keep excess or expired medication around the home. Improper disposal in your trash allows others to divert the substance and consume medication that was not prescribed to them.

Prevent water pollution, Promote a healthy environment, and Properly dispose of your unneeded and expired medication.

What is E-Waste?

Electronic waste (E-Waste): discarded computers and other consumer electronics including items like laptops, personal computers, televisions, and cell phones.

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

DVD'S, VHS TAPES, FLOPPIES AND CD'S, TOASTER OVENS, BLENDERS, VACUUM CLEANERS, OR ANY ELECTRONICS HOUSED IN WOOD CABINETS.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT CARTONS

- **What is a carton?**

Cartons are a type of packaging for food and beverage products you can purchase at the store. They are easy to recognize and are available in two types—shelf-stable and refrigerated. Examples are:

Shelf-stable cartons – found on shelves in the grocery store

Juice
Milk
Soy Milk
Soup and broth
Wine

Refrigerated – found in the chilled sections of grocery stores

Milk
Juice
Cream
Egg Substitutes

- **What are cartons made from?**

Cartons are mainly made from paper in the form of paperboard, as well as thin layers of polyethylene (plastic), and/or aluminum. Shelf-stable cartons contain on average 74% paper, 22% polyethylene, and 4% aluminum. Refrigerated cartons contain about 80% paper and 20% polyethylene.

- **How do I recycle cartons?**

Simply place the cartons in your container with comingled glass food jars/beverage bottles; aluminum beverage cans; steel food/beverage cans; plastic soda/milk/water bottles and other plastic coded 1 through 7. DO NOT PLACE THEM WITH PAPER RECYCLABLES. Caps and straws should be removed before recycling. Cartons should be rinsed to insure sanitary storage.
