

Ginty & Streeter Pool Bathhouse Renovations Making Great Progress

Last September the Township of Morris began a major renovation of the Bathhouse facilities at both the Ginty and Streeter Swimming Pools. When pool members return for the 2008 season opening on June 7th, they will find clean and bright new bathrooms, showers, and changing areas. Each pool received the installation of a new Family Bathroom also suitable for use by individuals with disabilities. New drop ceilings were installed in the bathrooms and new bright white ceilings were installed in the Arcade areas. New lighting fixtures have been installed in all public areas and ceiling fans have been installed in the bathrooms to boost internal air circulation. Probably the most sought after improvement is the installation of a new on-demand hot water system for the bathrooms and the showers – ending the days of short, cold water showers of the past.
